Background: CD3ε is a 20 kD chain of the CD3/T cell receptor (TCR) complex, which is composed of

two CD3 $\epsilon$ , one CD3 $\gamma$ , one CD3 $\delta$ , one CD3 $\zeta$  (CD247), and a T cell receptor ( $\alpha/\beta$  or  $\gamma/\delta$ ) heterodimer. It is found on all mature T lymphocytes, NK T cells, and some thymocytes. CD3, also known as T3, is a member of the immunoglobulin superfamily that plays a role

in antigen recognition, signal transduction, and T cell activation.



Recommended Usage:

Each lot of this antibody is quality control tested by flow cytometric analysis. The amount of the reagent is suggested to be used 5  $\mu$ L of antibody per test (million cells in 100  $\mu$ L staining volume or per 100  $\mu$ L of whole blood). Please check your vial before the experiment. Since applications vary, the appropriate dilutions must be determined for individual use.
