Lyophilized from a 0.2µm filtered concentrated solution in PBS, pH 7.4.

Purity:

Greater than 90.0% as determined by SDS-PAGE.

Solubility:

It is recommended to reconstitute the lyophilized Vascular Endothelial Growth Factor in sterile $18M\Omega$ -cm H2O not less than $100\mu g/ml$, which can then be further diluted to other aqueous solutions.

Stability:

Lyophilized VEGF although stable at room temperature for 3 weeks, should be stored desiccated below - 18°C. Upon reconstitution Vascular Endothelial Growth Factor should be stored at 4°C between 2-7 days and for future use below -18°C.Please prevent freeze-thaw cycles.

Biological Activity:

The ED50 was measured in a cell proliferation assay using HUVEC human umbilical vein endothelial cells and was found to be 0.75-3.75 ng/ml.
