 Store Bradford Reagent at Room Temperature for 1 Year.

**Storage Buffer:** Liquid in 50mM Tris-Glycine(pH 7.4), 0.15M NaCl, 40%Glycerol, 0.01% sodium azide and 0.05% BSA.
