Storage: Store at -20°C. Avoid freeze / thaw cycles. Buffer: PBS containing 50% glycerol and 0.05% BSA, preserved with proclin300 or sodium azide (as specified on the Certificate of Analysis), pH 7.3.

Store Bradford Reagent at Room Temperature for 1 Year.

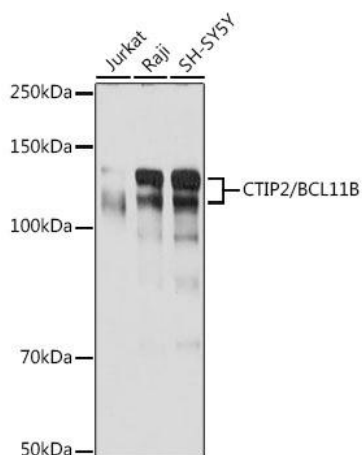

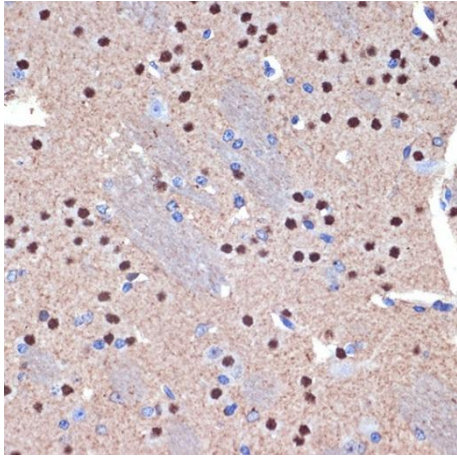

Western blot analysis of various lysates using CTIP2/BCL11B Rabbit mAb (CAB19804) at 1:1000 dilution. Secondary antibody: HRP-conjugated Goat anti-Rabbit IgG (H+L) (CABS014) at 1:10000 dilution. Lysates/proteins: 25µg per lane. Blocking buffer: 3% nonfat dry milk in TBST. Detection: ECL Basic Kit (AbGn00020). Exposure time: 1s.



Immunohistochemistry analysis of paraffin-embedded Mouse brain using CTIP2/BCL11B Rabbit mAb (CAB19804) at dilution of 1:100 (40x lens). Microwave antigen retrieval performed with 0.01M Tris/EDTA Buffer (pH 9.0) prior to IHC staining.
