
Store Bradford Reagent at Room Temperature for 1 Year.



Western blot analysis of lysates from wild type (WT) and 293T cells transfected with IKK β siRNA using IKK β Rabbit pAb (CAB2087) at 1:5000 dilution incubated overnight at 4°C. Secondary antibody: HRP-conjugated Goat anti-Rabbit IgG (H+L) (CABS014) at 1:10000 dilution. Lysates/proteins: 20 µg per lane. Blocking buffer: 3% nonfat dry milk in TBST. Detection: ECL Basic Kit (AbGn00020). Exposure time: 10 s.



Immunofluorescence analysis of NIH/3T3 cells using IKK β Rabbit pAb (CAB2087) at dilution of 1:100 (40x lens). Secondary antibody: Cy3-conjugated Goat anti-Rabbit IgG (H+L) (CABS007) at 1:500 dilution. Blue: DAPI for nuclear staining.
