**Storage:** Store at -20°C. Avoid freeze / thaw cycles. Buffer: PBS containing 50% glycerol, preserved with proclin300 or sodium azide (as specified on the Certificate of Analysis), pH 7.3.


Store Bradford Reagent at Room Temperature for 1 Year.

## Validation Data



Western blot analysis of various lysates using /PDPK1 Rabbit pAb (CAB21810) at 1:5000 dilution. Secondary antibody: HRP-conjugated Goat anti-Rabbit IgG (H+L) (CABS014) at 1:10000 dilution. Lysates/proteins: 25µg per lane. Blocking buffer: 3% nonfat dry milk in TBST. Detection: ECL Basic Kit (AbGn00020). Exposure time: 1s.
