Store Bradford Reagent at Room Temperature for 1 Year.

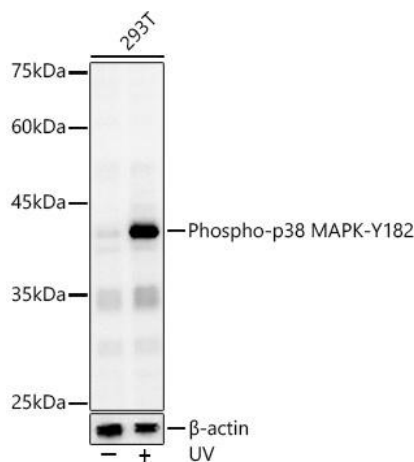

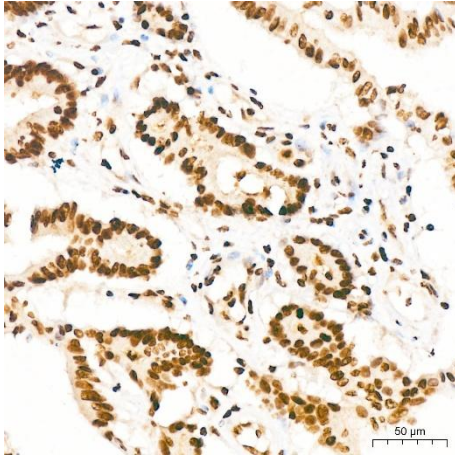

Western blot analysis of lysates from 293T cells, using Phospho-p38 MAPK- Rabbit pAb (CABP0057) at 1:1000 dilution. Secondary antibody: HRP-conjugated Goat anti-Rabbit IgG (H+L) (CABS014) at 1:10000 dilution. Lysates/proteins: 25µg per lane. Blocking buffer: 3% nonfat dry milk in TBST. Detection: ECL Enhanced Kit (AbGn00021). Exposure time: 30s.



Immunohistochemistry analysis of paraffin-embedded Human colon carcinoma tissue using Phospho-p38 MAPK- Rabbit pAb (CABP0057) at a dilution of 1:100 (40x lens). High pressure antigen retrieval was performed with 0.01 M citrate buffer (pH 6.0) prior to IHC staining.
