## Preparation & Storage

---

**Storage:** Store at -20°C. Avoid freeze / thaw cycles. Buffer: PBS containing 50% glycerol and 0.05% BSA, preserved with proclin300 or sodium azide (as specified on the Certificate of Analysis), pH 7.3.

Store Bradford Reagent at Room Temperature for 1 Year.

**Positive Sample:** NIH/3T3 treated with pervanadate

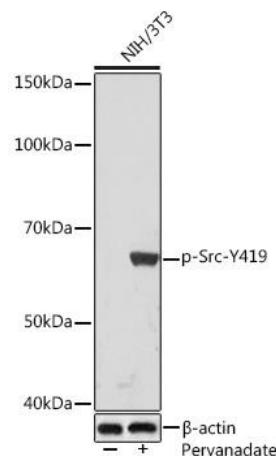
**Recommended Dilutions:**

WB	1:500 - 1:1000
ELISA	Recommended starting concentration is 1 µg/mL. Please optimize the concentration based on your specific assay requirements.

## Validation Data

Western blot analysis of lysates from NIH/3T3 cells, using Phospho-Src- Rabbit mAb (CABP1027) at 1:1000 dilution. NIH/3T3 cells were treated with pervanadate (1 mM) at 37°C for 30 minutes after serum-starvation overnight. Secondary antibody: HRP-conjugated Goat anti-Rabbit IgG (H+L) (CABS014) at 1:10000 dilution. Lysates/proteins: 25µg per lane. Blocking buffer: 3% BSA. Detection: ECL Basic Kit (AbGn00020). Exposure time: 3min.
