## Preparation & Storage

**Storage:** Store at -20°C. Avoid freeze / thaw cycles. Buffer: PBS with 0.09% Sodium azide, 0.05% BSA, 50% glycerol, pH 7.3.

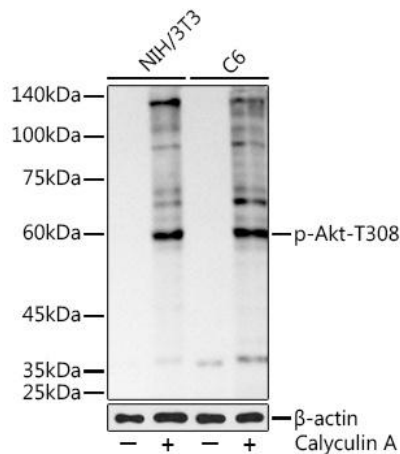
Store Bradford Reagent at Room Temperature for 1 Year.

**Positive Sample:** NIH/3T3 treated with Calyculin A, C6 treated with Calyculin A

<b>Recommended Dilutions:</b>	<b>WB</b>	1:500 - 1:1000

## Validation Data



Western blot analysis of various lysates using Phospho-Akt- Rabbit mAb (CABP1259) at 1:1000 dilution. NIH/3T3 and cells were treated with Calyculin A (100 nM) at 37°C for 30 minutes after serum-starvation overnight. Secondary antibody: HRP-conjugated Goat anti-Rabbit IgG (H+L) (CABS014) at 1:10000 dilution. Lysates/proteins: 25µg per lane. Blocking buffer: 3% nonfat dry milk in TBST. Detection: ECL Basic Kit (AbGn00020). Exposure time: 180s.
