
Storage: Upon receipt, store at -20°C or -80°C. Avoid repeated freeze. Store Bradford Reagent at Room Temperature for 1 Year.






Description

Immunohistochemistry of paraffin-embedded human skin tissue using PACO41242 at dilution of 1:100



Immunohistochemistry of paraffin-embedded human small intestine tissue using PACO41242 at dilution of 1:100



Immunofluorescence staining of MCF-7 cells with PACO41242 at 1:400, counterstained with DAPI. The cells were fixed in 4% formaldehyde, permeabilized using 0.2% Triton X-100 and blocked in 10% normal Goat Serum. The cells were then incubated with the antibody overnight at 4°C. The secondary antibody was Alexa Fluor 488-conjugated AffiniPure Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG(H+L).
