

Recombinant Rat E-Selectin/SELE Protein (Fc Tag)

Description

This high-purity recombinant protein is supplied as a kit for advanced applications. The kit includes Bradford Reagent to quantify total protein concentration for accurate sample normalization (Optional).

Storage: Generally, lyophilized proteins are stable for up to 12 months when stored at -20 to -80 °C. Reconstituted protein solution can be stored at 4-8°C for 2-7 days. Aliquots of reconstituted samples are stable at < -20°C for 3 months.
Store Bradford Reagent at Room Temperature for 1 year.

Tag: C-hFc

Shipping: This product is provided as lyophilized powder which is shipped with ice packs.

Expression Host: HEK293 Cells

Bio-Activity: Measured by the ability of the immobilized protein to support the adhesion of U937 cells. When 5 x 10⁴ cells/well are added to SELE-coated plates (2 µg/mL and 100 µL/well), approximately > 85% cells will adhere specifically after 60 minutes at 37°C.

Calculated MW: 78.8 kDa

Formulation: Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4. Normally 5% - 8% trehalose, mannitol and 0.01% Tween 80 are added as protectants before lyophilization. Please refer to the specific buffer information in the printed manual.

Observed MW: 114-119 kDa
