Storage: Generally, lyophilized proteins are stable for up to 12 months when stored at -20 to -80 °C. Reconstituted protein solution can be stored at 4-8°C for 2-7 days. Aliquots of reconstituted samples are stable at < -20°C for 3 months.
Store Bradford Reagent at Room Temperature for 1 year.

Tag: C-Fc

Shipping: This product is provided as lyophilized powder which is shipped with ice packs.

Expression Host: HEK293 Cells

Bio-Activity: Immobilized Human 4-1BBL-His(Cat: RPES1680) at 10 µg/ml(100 µl/well) can bind Human 4-1BB-Fc. The ED50 of Human 4-1BB-Fc is 16. 8 ng/ml.

Calculated MW: 44.2 kDa

Formulation: Lyophilized from a 0.2 µm filtered solution of PBS, pH 7.4. Normally 5% - 8% trehalose, mannitol and 0.01% Tween 80 are added as protectants before lyophilization. Please refer to the specific buffer information in the printed manual.

Observed MW: 58 kDa
