Store Bradford Reagent at Room Temperature for 1 year.

**Formulation:** Lyophilized from sterile 50mM Tris, 100mM NaCl, 0.5mM PMSF, 0.5mM EDTA, 0.5mM GSH, pH 8.0 Normally 5% - 8% trehalose, mannitol and 0.01% Tween 80 are added as protectants before lyophilization. Please refer to the specific buffer information in the printed manual.
